1) DEVELOPING A GROWTH SEEKING MINDSET

5) CO-REGULATION FOR CONNECTION

- Learn why coregulation is so important
- Learn how to create and maintain states of coregulation
- Coregulation is the foundation for self-regulation
- Critical aspect of human connection and development and often missed in the lives of individuals with Autism

SUPPORTING EYE GAZING – NOT EYE CONTACT

- Learn how to analyze gaze shifting to understand what others are thinking and developmental readiness
- Eye gazing is dynamic communication – why we don't teach "look at me"
- How to create opportunities to improve eye gazing, observation skills and attention

LIMIT SETTING – DEVELOPING COMPETENCY IN SETTING LOVING AND KIND BOUNDARIES (3 PART SERIES)

- Parents learn that they must set limits with their children even when they have autism
- Why setting limits is loving and kind, why kids need to hear no
- Difference between punishments and rewards and healthy boundaries Knowing when and how to set limits, developmental readiness is vital
